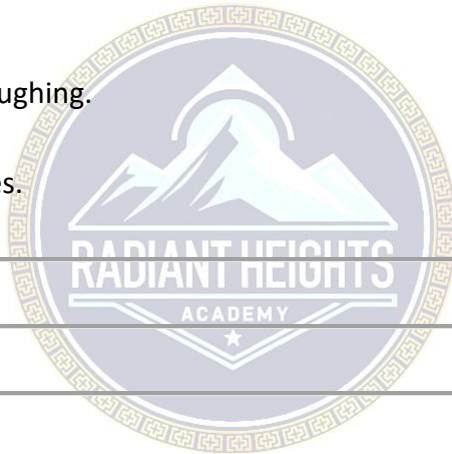

Everyone shouted, "Happy Birthday!"

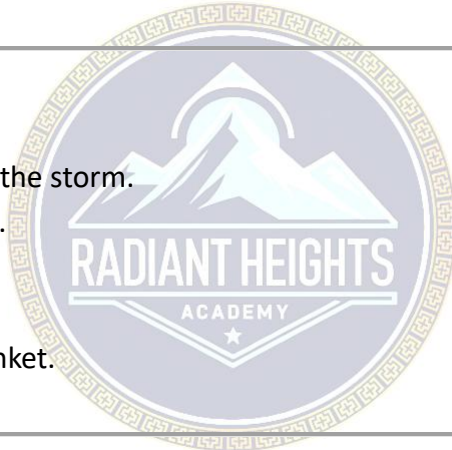

She wrapped herself tightly in a blanket.

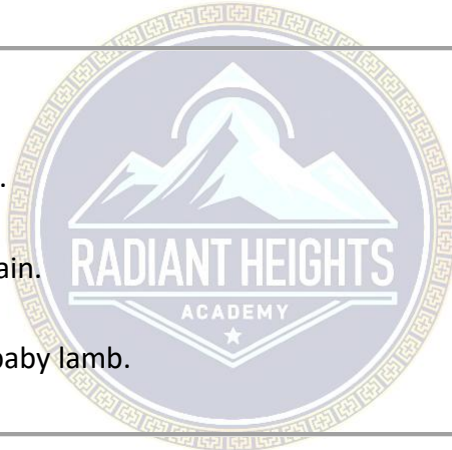


Question 1 🧑🏫

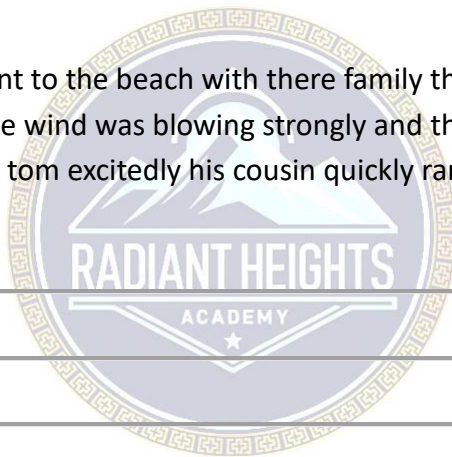

Question 2

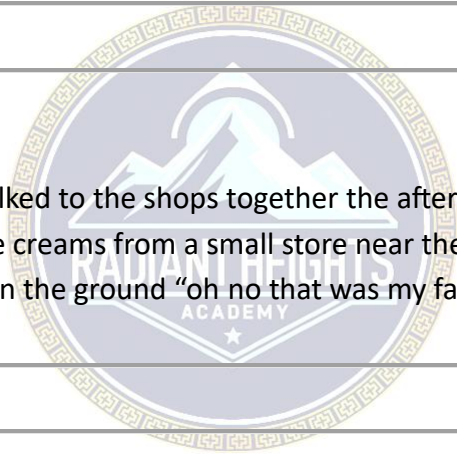

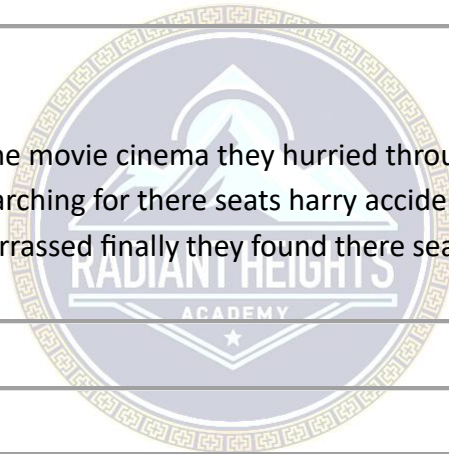


Question 1 🐎

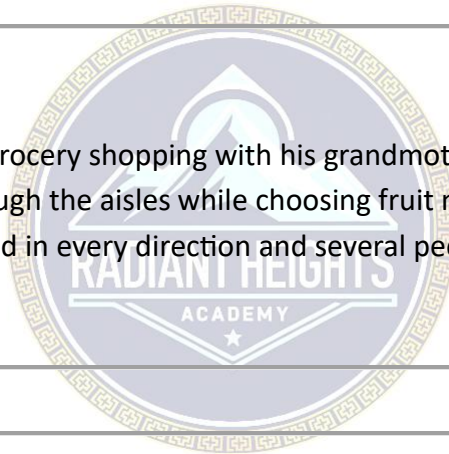


Question 1
